Background

A New York native with a private equity background, Santos's campaign to represent Long Island's North Shore-centered competitive district centered on critiques of Democratic policies

Born and raised in New York City, in the Jackson Heights neighborhood, in a family of Angolan, Ukrainian, and Brazilian descent; spent more than a decade in the private equity industry, working for Citigroup and other asset management companies

First ran for Congress in 2020 and won the Republican nomination without entering a primary; lost to incumbent Rep. Tom Suozzi (D-NY3) in the general election, and made claims of fraud, ballot harvesting, voter suppression, and election tampering

Attended the "Stop the Steal" rally on January 6, 2021, and referred to President Joe Biden's inauguration as "a hostile takeover of our country" on a podcast hosted by Lara Trump

Highly critical of the Biden administration, stating that the Biden cabinet was "all appointed through affirmative action" in an OAN interview, and asserts that impeaching Biden and top cabinet officials might be the only way to improve the country
